Advise Texas Counseling Program

Works to increase the number of low-income, first-generation college, and underrepresented high school students who enter and complete a postsecondary education.

88% of RHS seniors applied to college and 7.4 million dollars in scholarships awarded.

RHS students completed 1,884 AP Exams during the 2016-17 school year.
